Karen I. Wilson Scholarship Student groups: LVN-RN Transition and Paramedic to RN only (2 - \$1000.00 awards)

Must be in second semester or higher of program

G.P.A. of minimum 3.0 in nursing courses

Elide Lee Scholarship Student group: LVN-RN Transition only (\$500.00 per semester)

Must be in second or third semester of program

In your narrative discuss previous and current nursing practice as a LVN and plans for practice upon graduation.

Jeremy McLeaish Scholarship - Student group: Traditional track nursing student (1- \$1000.00 (\$500 Fall and Spring semesters)

Must be in third semester.
