



Nursing & Allied Health Scholarship Criteria

Overview:

In order to provide an opportunity to individuals from the local communities interested in pursuing a career in a medical field, The South Texas Health System has established a South Texas College Nursing and Allied Health Scholarship. Scholarship applications are open to students majoring in any healthcare field of study at South Texas College.

The scholarship is merit based and will be used toward the cost of educational expenses.

Procedures:

The award will be granted based on the following minimum criteria:

- Applicants must be taking courses offered at South Texas College that are on a degree plan leading to an AAS degree in a healthcare field or have been admitted to a selective admission program at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale and be passing all coursework in the healthcare field of study with a "C" or better.
- Applicants must submit a complete application package.
- Applicants must be enrolled in 12 or more hours per semester or enrolled in a selective admission healthcare program.
- Applicants must submit a one page essay stating why you need the scholarship.
