



Nursing & Allied Health College Success for Healthcare Scholarship

Overview:

In order to provide a scholarship opportunity to individuals from the local communities who are pursuing a career in a healthcare, South Texas College Nursing & Allied Health division has established a College Success for Healthcare Scholarship. Scholarship applications are open to students majoring in any healthcare field of study at South Texas College who have successfully completed the course, College Success for Healthcare as indicated below.

The scholarship is merit based and must be used toward the cost of educational expenses.

Procedures:

The award will be granted based on the following *minimum criteria*:

- Applicants must have received a grade of “A” or a “B” in the course College Success for Healthcare at South Texas College. This could have been in the course designated ORIN0101 only if it was also a “College Success for Healthcare” section, or in any course designated CSFH0101.
- Applicants must be taking courses offered at South Texas College that are on a degree plan leading to an AAS degree or Certificate in a healthcare field or have been admitted to a healthcare program at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and be passing all coursework in the healthcare field of study with a “C” or better.
- Applicants must submit a complete application package.
- Applicants must be enrolled in 12 or more hours per semester or enrolled in a selective admission healthcare program.
- Applicants must submit a one-page essay stating why they need the scholarship.
